He currently is a self employed private investigator who is hired by law firms, corporations and organizations to perform a variety of investigative activities, including interviewing, child custodial matters, accident scene investigations, people find, unlawful death, jail house assaults, unlawful dismissal, sexual harassment and discrimination, marital situations, physical and electronic surveillance and health care facility abuse investigations.*
